When starting a new conversation, the first message can often be the trickiest. Below are a list of questions created to make the initial message easier for you to start the conversation.

While these questions are great to start the conversation, remember that you still need to introduce yourself in the message. This message should also include key information such as your name, the course you've completed and your ambitions for your career.

**Note:** *You can modify the question to better match your tone and make it sound more organic.*

## Mentee asking Mentor Questions

## Mentor asking Mentee Questions

- Networking can be a powerful tool in building your career. Have you started connecting with professionals in your desired industry. would you like some advice on that?
- Are there any areas of your skillset you'd like to develop further? How can I support you in that?

- There's a lot to learn about the industry, and I'm happy to share insights from my experience. Is there a particular aspect of the industry you're curious about or would like to discuss in depth?
