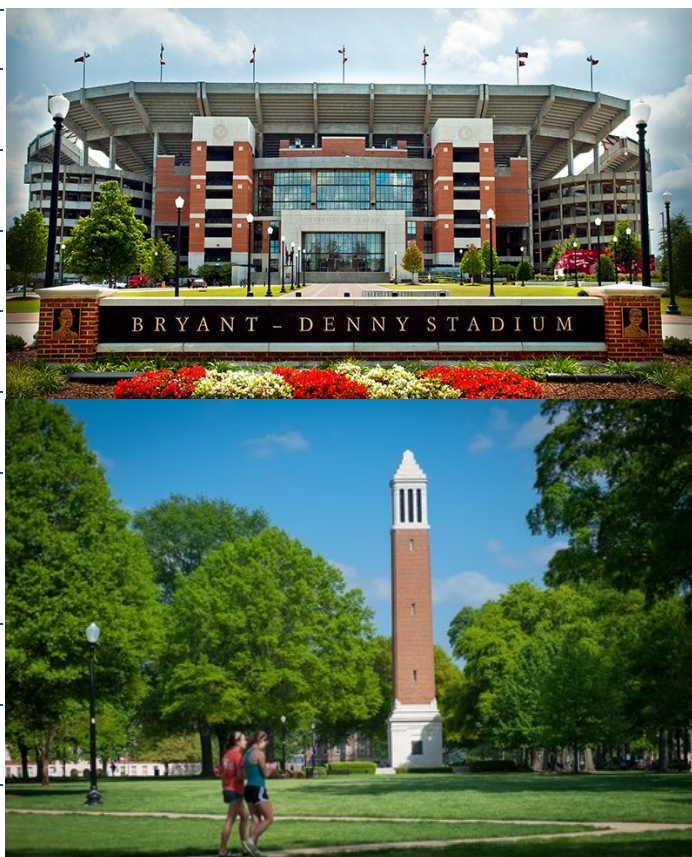

Description

The University of Alabama is a public University established in 1831. It is well known for its law school, which ranks 9th among public universities in the USA. This large University has 38,000 students studying across 200 degree programmes. The campus houses over 500 student clubs and organisations.

Facilities on the 1200-acre campus, regularly ranked amongst the most beautiful in the US, include an American Football stadium, Olympic swimming pool, fitness centre, and basketball courts.

UWE Law students studying here join the Juris Doctor programme for a full academic year.

Surrounding Area

Tuscaloosa is the fifth largest city in Alabama, with an estimated population of 100,000. It is a college town, home to the University of Alabama, Stillman College and Shelton State Community College.

In recent years, Tuscaloosa has been named "America's Most Livable City", and has been ranked within the "50 Best College Towns". The city is in easy reach of Nashville, Memphis and New Orleans.

Accommodation

Students are supported in finding their own private accommodation by the University. Accommodation starts around \$550 per month for a room in a shared apartment/house.
